## PRIMETIME macrame wall hanging

## ORIGINAL TUTORIAL HERE



- You should have 6 long strings and 8 short strings.
- Tie all 6 long strings onto your wooden dowel using a lark's head knot.
- Starting with the middle two cords, make a row of diagonal double half hitch knots to the left.
- Repeat the diagonal double half hitch knots to the right.
- Repeat the last two steps leaving out the cords on the outsides of your piece.
- Use the middle four cords to tie a square knot.
- Thread your bead onto the middle two cords and then tie it on with another square knot.
- Complete your inner diamond by making a row of diagonal double half hitch knots to the left and right.
- Using a lark's head knot, add one of your short cords to the outer strings of your large diamond, then complete those rows with diagonal double half hitch knots as you did with the small diamond.
- Repeat the steps above, removing the outside two cords for each new diamond (to make them progressively smaller). Once you have all of your diamonds, tie off the bottom, add fringe by adding small cords into the gaps using lark's head knots, and comb out the fringe.
